rediATM



Accessing your money with Macquarie Credit Union is easy, there are a variety of options to choose from. Choose from one of our simple options below.

Internet & Telephone Banking

Access your accounts and pay your bills over the phone or online 24 hours a day, seven days a week at your convenience.

Bank@Post

Deposit or withdraw at over 3,100 post office outlets around the country.

BPAY®

Pay all those tiresome bills in one hit - over the phone or over the internet around the clock, 365 days a year.

Personal Cheque Books

A personal cheque book can be used to operate your Access Account (S5).

Visa Debit Card

All the benefits of a VISA Credit Card but without any interest charges or fees as you access your own funds from your Access Account (S5).

rediATM

The large RediATM network includes NAB and BOQ ATMs. Withdraw cash or check your balance without paying Direct Charge fees 24 hours a day.

Direct Debit/Credit Services

Specify the recipient, amount and the nominated intervals for regular payments.

Payroll Deductions

Elect to have a certain amount taken out of your pay and forwarded to your accounts every pay day. Set up automatic bill payments or break your accounts up and save some of your pay.

FEE FREEDOM

Banking without fees is still available from your Credit Union.

Here are a few ways to help you minimise your fees and even help you bank fee-free.

Do all of your banking with your Credit Union – while all our members receive some free transactions on their accounts each month, our loyalty program offers more free transactions to those members who do most of their banking with us.

Consolidate your banking – having multiple memberships can make it easier to over-transact and therefore pay more in fees. Where possible reduce the number of accounts you have.

Take cash out when using EFTPOS – use EFTPOS to withdraw cash when purchasing goods or services. This counts as only one transaction.

Reduce the number of withdrawals you make – think, plan ahead and withdraw larger amounts less frequently.

Save time and money by banking online and over the phone – use internet or telephone banking to obtain balances, transfer funds between accounts and pay your bills through BPAY.

Use rediATMs – when withdrawing cash from an ATM always use a rediATM to avoid direct charging.

Keep track of your account balances – ensure you always have sufficient cleared funds in your account to cover all withdrawals, and use an overdraft as a safety net.

Select credit when using your VISA Debit Card and it's always a FREE transaction.
